



LEARN ON A MONDAY

The next 4 sessions will be on 2, 16, 23 and 30 November 2009.

We meet in St Mary's Church Centre starting at 7.30pm (Coffee from 7.15pm). We finish with Compline at 9pm.

At our last meeting on 19 October we discussed our programme for November and decided to spend the 4 sessions on studying and discussing the Eucharist. We will look at the Biblical roots and authority for the Eucharist, and at the way the liturgy has evolved over nearly 2000 years. We will then look at our own Common Worship liturgy in depth and explore the beliefs behind both words and actions. We will also look at the ways other Churches celebrate the Eucharist: what is similar or identical and what is different.

Do consider joining us. We are a group of around 40 people, and there are about 25 at each meeting; not everybody is able to attend every time. A reading pack is put out before each session for those who wish to prepare in advance. I usually introduce the subject for 20-30 minutes and then we have small group discussions for about an hour. Our guiding principles are openness, honesty and respect for each others opinions, questions and doubts. We journey together in love (and some laughter!).
